

NAAATT Announces CARIFTA Team 2018



Bahamas will host the 47th Edition of the CARIFTA Games on March 30th to April 2nd 2018 at the Thomas Robinson Stadium. The Games will bring together some 500 athletes and 150 team officials from 26 countries, all among the best track and field athletes in the Caribbean. The Games consists of 65 track and field events including sprint races, hurdles, middle distance track events, jumping, throwing events, and relays in line with the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) guidelines for junior athletes. The Games has two age categories: under-17 and under-20.

Since 1990 Team TTO has amassed 560 medals: 157 Gold; 197 Silver and 206 Bronze, currently holding five Games records such as Boys under 20 Hurdles Jehue Gordon 49.76 on 4th April, 2010. With a medal count of 7 gold, 5 silver and 10 bronze totaling 22 in 2017 which was a vast improvement over the 2016 Games hosted in Grenada with a medal tally of 14 medals, the country's smallest total since the 1993 Games in Martinique.
